Why should I attend a support group?

Finding groups to connect with can be challenging. This is a safe place to confidentially share your struggles and triumphs with a group of your peers. Michigan Medicine staff members join the groups to guide discussions and provide information.



What is the group's purpose?

This group is for individuals with a diagnosis of a brain aneurysm or arteriovenous malformation (AVM). Both those who have suffered a rupture and those who have not are welcome. Caregivers are also welcome.

Other details:

- This group is free to join.
- Participants must have their own phone or computer and internet access.
- You don't have to join on video.

When does the group meet?

Meetings are held 4 times a year on Thursday evenings from 5:00 PM - 6:00 PM.

Where does the group meet?
