What is a transition letter?

A transition letter is a notarized document that you can submit to change your birth certificate to the appropriate gender.

What is the process for obtaining a transition letter?

After your gender confirming surgery is complete, you can contact Dr. Kuzon's administrative assistant to obtain a transition letter. There is a notary public in the Department of Surgery that can prepare, notarize the document and obtain Dr. Kuzon's signature.
