This plan contains UMHHC policies and procedures which outline infection control practices for protection of employees and patients. In particular, these documents outline the employees who will receive training, protective personal equipment, vaccination and other provisions of OSHA's Bloodborne Pathogens Standard. This plan is reviewed at least annually by Infection Control & Epidemiology.

Schedule and Method of Implementation

Components of the plan are:

- 1) **Exposure determination**
Exposure job classification

- 2) **Employee Health Services procedures**
Management of exposure to bloodborne pathogens
Chemoprophylaxis after occupational exposure to HIV
Prevention of viral hepatitis among personnel

- 3) **Methods of Compliance**
Body substance precautions
Handwashing policy
Cleaning blood and body fluid spills
Managers' responsibilities
Safe practice and infectious diseases' workbook
Affiliation agreement with schools

- 4) **Sharps Management**
Disposal of sharp objects and glass policy
Body substance exposure task force

- 5) **Waste Management**
Protocol for regulated medical waste management
