

How to use your Advair HFA (fluticasone/salmeterol) Inhaler

45mcg/21mcg, 115mcg/21mcg, 230mcg/21mcg



What is my prescription?	Special Instructions
	Take every day to control your
	symptoms.
	Rinse mouth thoroughly with water
	and spit after each use.

What can I expect while I take this medication?

Advair® HFA will not provide immediate relief, but you can expect fewer episodes of coughing and wheezing.

How and when to prime your Advair® HFA:

- 1. Prime inhaler if new, has not been used in 4 weeks, or if you drop it.
- 2. Remove cap, shake inhaler for 5 seconds, spray it once away from you and repeat for a total of 3 sprays.

How to use your Advair® HFA:

- 1. Remove **Advair** ® cap.
- 2. Place middle or index finger on top of canister and thumb underneath the mouthpiece of the inhaler.
- 3. Shake inhaler for 5-10 seconds.
- 4. Breathe out fully (in preparation to breathe in medication).
- 5. Put the mouthpiece in your mouth and close your lips around it. Do not block the mouthpiece with your teeth or tongue.
- 6. Push the top of the canister all the way down one time while breathing in deeply and slowly through your mouth.
- 7. Hold your breath for 5-10 seconds, and then breathe out.
- 8. If your doctor has prescribed more than one dose (puff), wait 30 seconds and repeat above.
- 9. Rinse mouth thoroughly with water after taking medication to decrease the risk of a mouth infection. Spit out the water. Do not swallow it.

How to clean your Advair® HFA:

Clean 1 time per week after your evening dose to prevent medicine from building up and blocking the spray.

- 1. Remove the cap.
- 2. Use a clean, dry swab to clean the small circular opening where the medicine sprays out of the canister.
- 3. Wipe the inside of the mouthpiece with a clean tissue dampened with water.
- 4. Let dry overnight.
- 5. Put the cap back over the mouthpiece after it has dried.

How to use a Spacer: (If recommended for use with your inhaler)

- 1. Remove mouthpiece cap from your inhaler and shake inhaler for 5-10 seconds.
- 2. Attach inhaler to spacer and then remove mouthpiece cap from spacer.

- 3. Hold spacer with the inhaler canister upright.
- 4. Breathe out fully (in preparation to inhale medication).
- 5. Tilt head back slightly and put spacer to mouth and close lips around the mouthpiece (tongue and teeth should not block the mouthpiece opening).
- 6. Release medicine into spacer; squeeze down canister **one** time.
- 7. Breathe the medication slowly and steadily. Continue to breathe in deeply until lungs are full (do not breathe out).
- 8. Hold your breath for 5-10 seconds, and then breathe out. (Repeat as directed).

Do not use Advair® HFA to treat sudden symptoms of your health condition. Always carry a rescue inhaler with you.
